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




1.2. NUMBER OF TOTAL VALID LICENSES, 2020-2024








3.2. GOLD PRODUCTION, 2019-2022, (2024.I.22), by kg, mined from hard rock and placer deposits

















5.2. BUDGET REVENUE OF MRPAM, 2020-2024, by billion MNT
