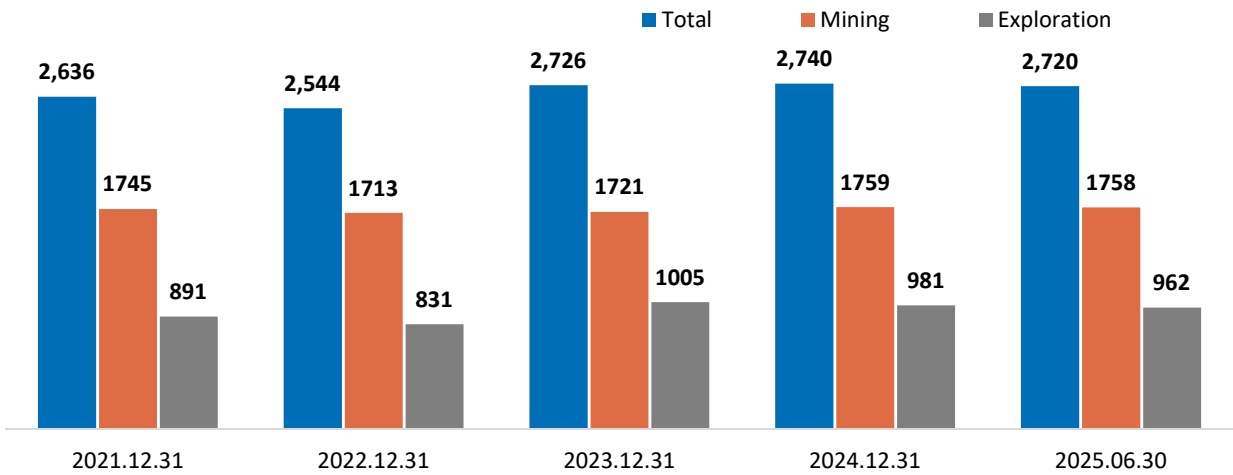

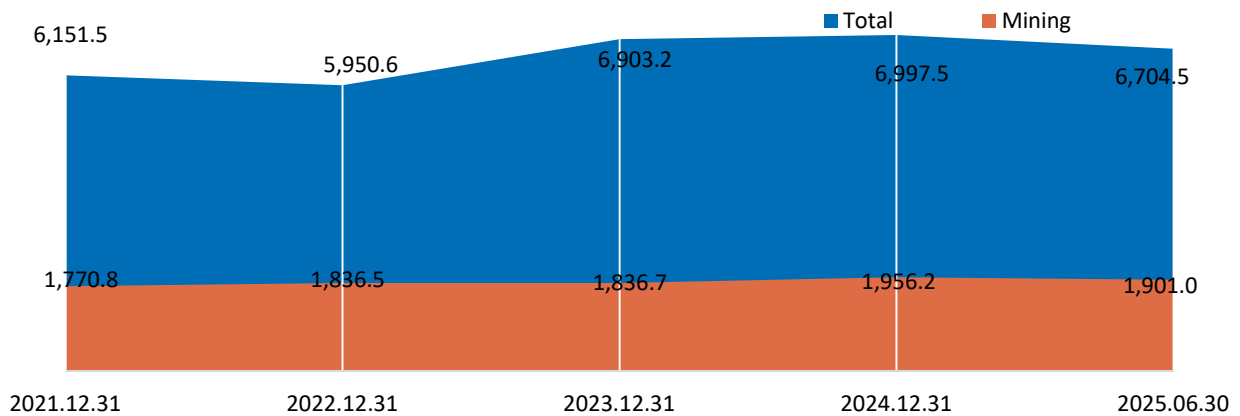

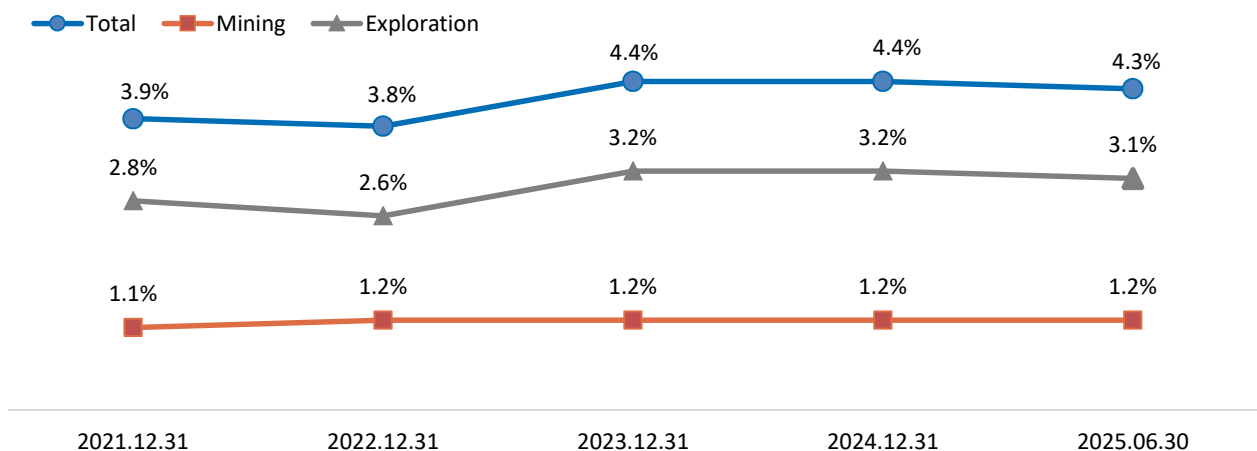
1.2. NUMBER OF TOTAL VALID LICENSES, 2021-2025

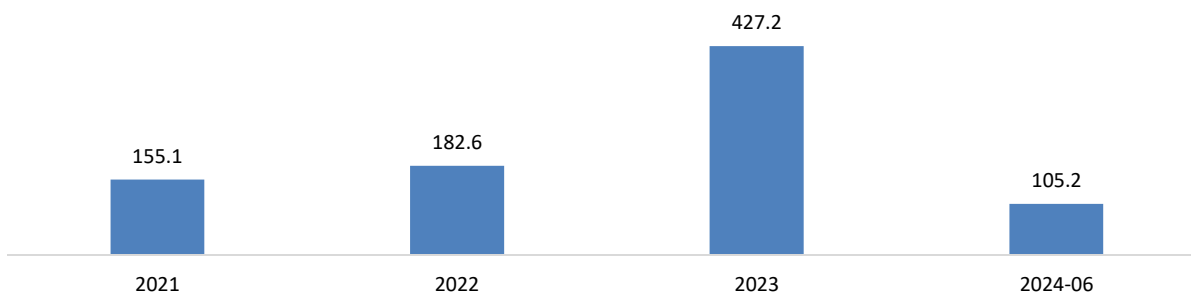

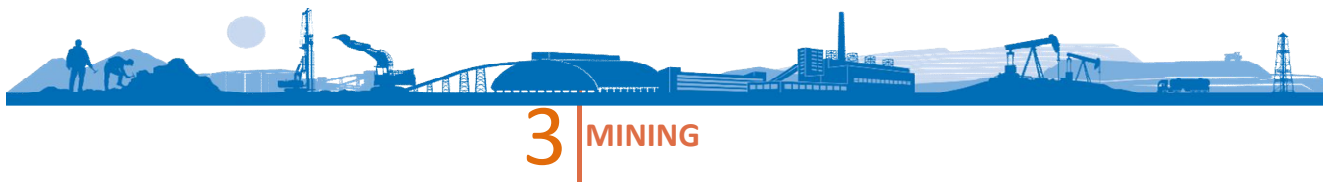

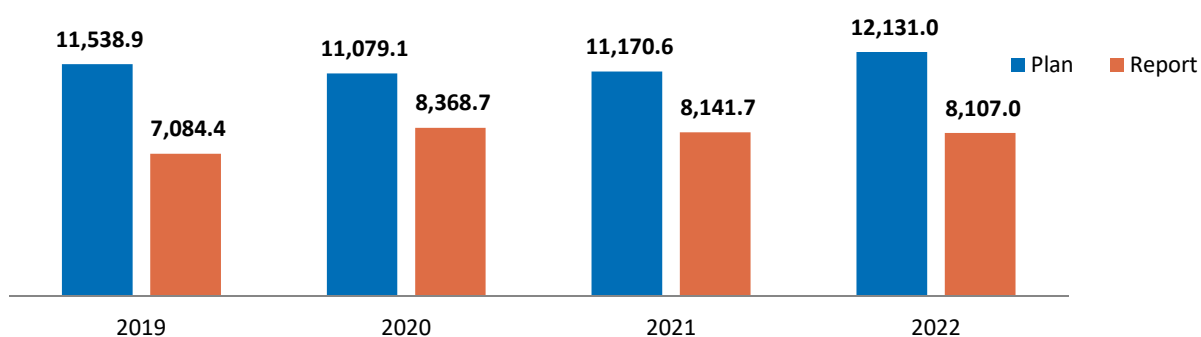

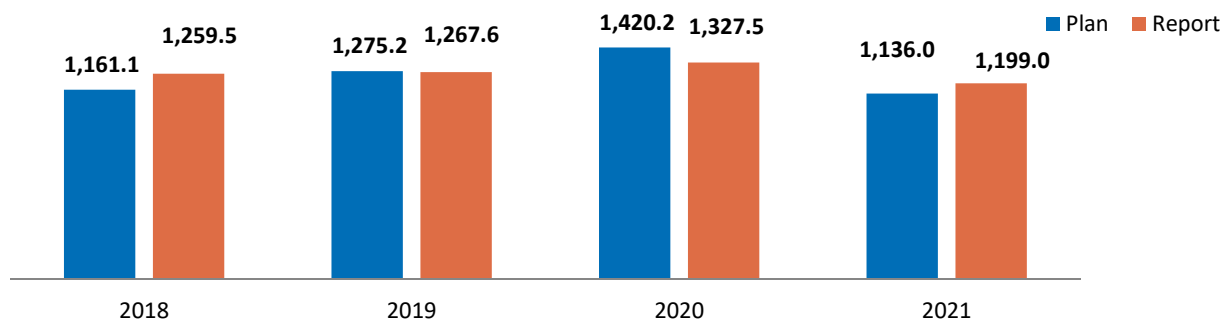

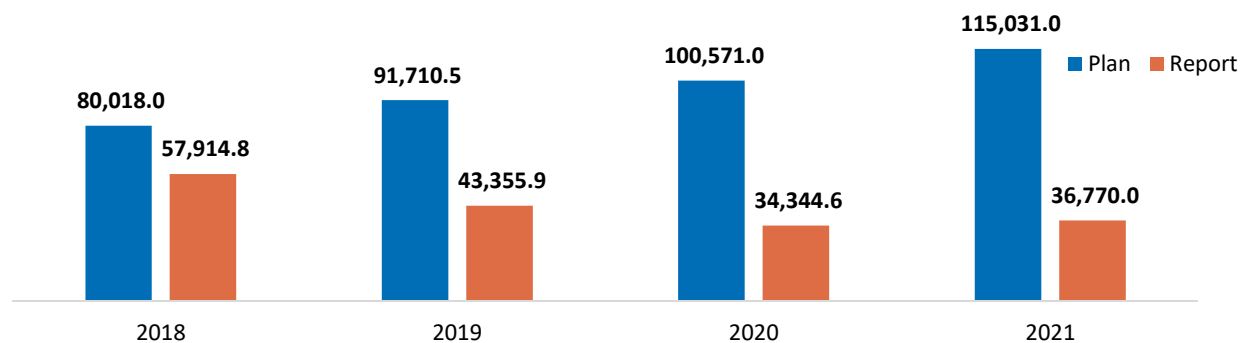
3.2. GOLD PRODUCTION, 2019-2022, (2024.01.22), by kg, mined from hard rock and placer deposits

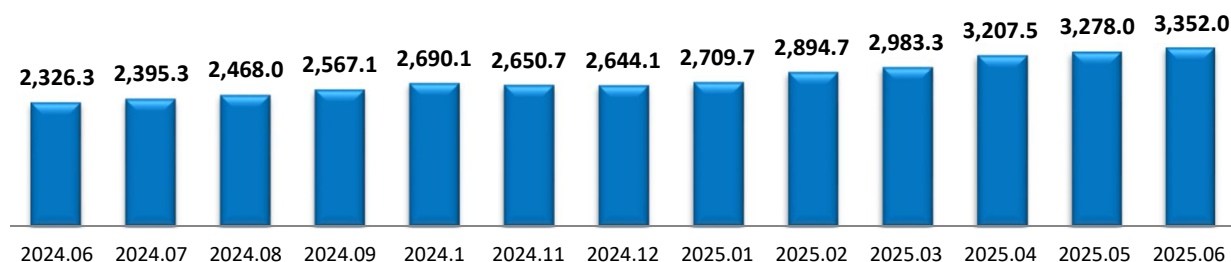

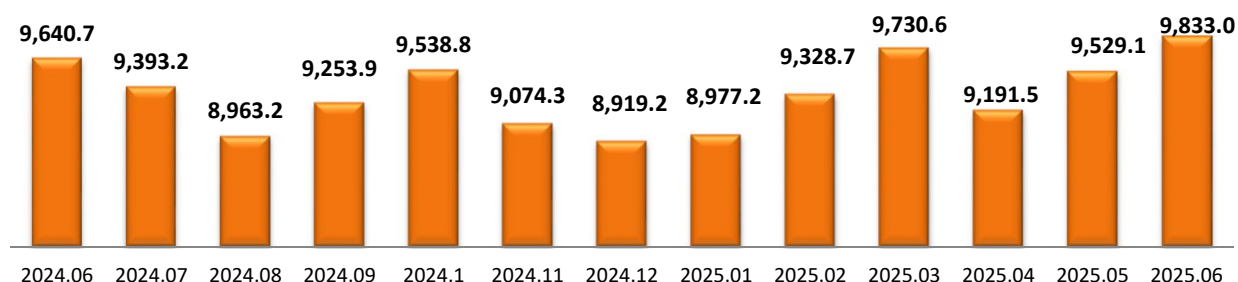

3.9. AVERAGE PRICE OF GOLD ON THE WORLD MARKET, in last 12 months, by US\$/ounce



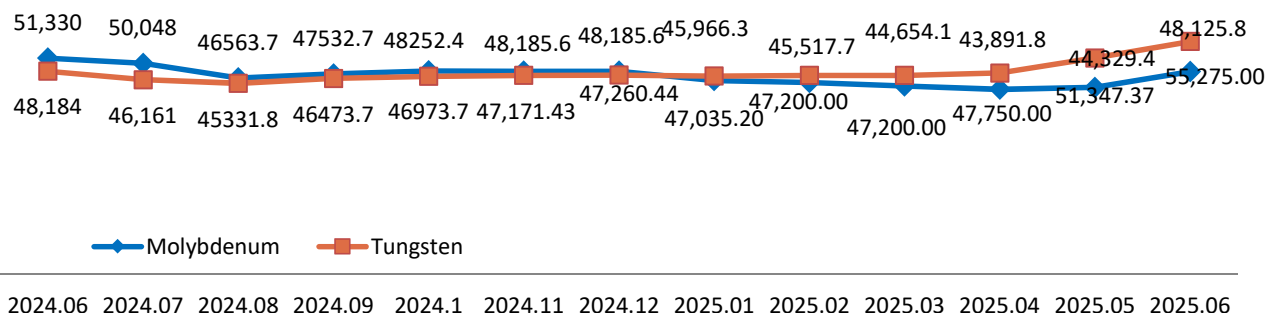
3.10. AVERAGE PRICE OF COPPER ON THE WORLD MARKET, in last 12 months, by US\$/tons



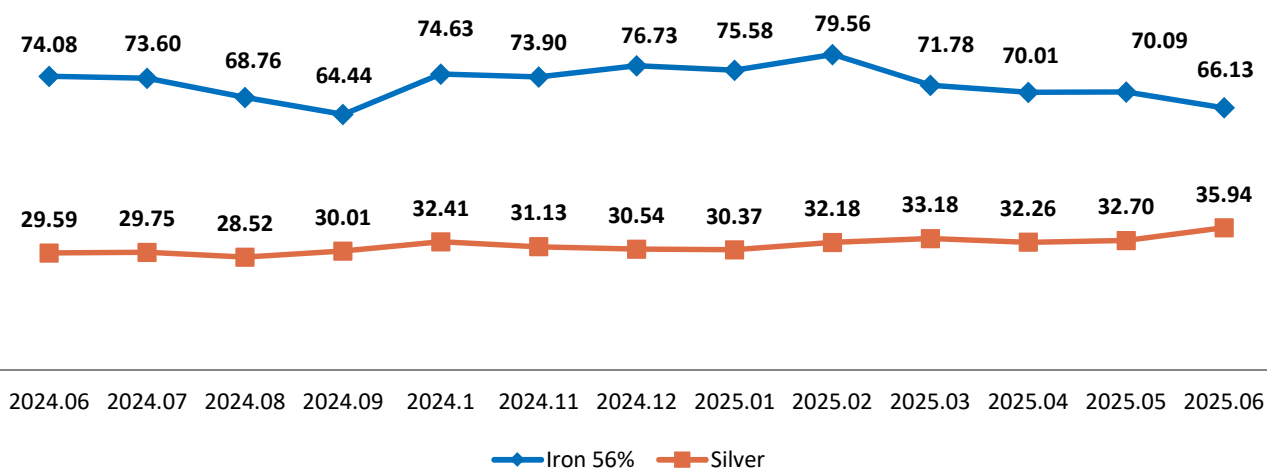

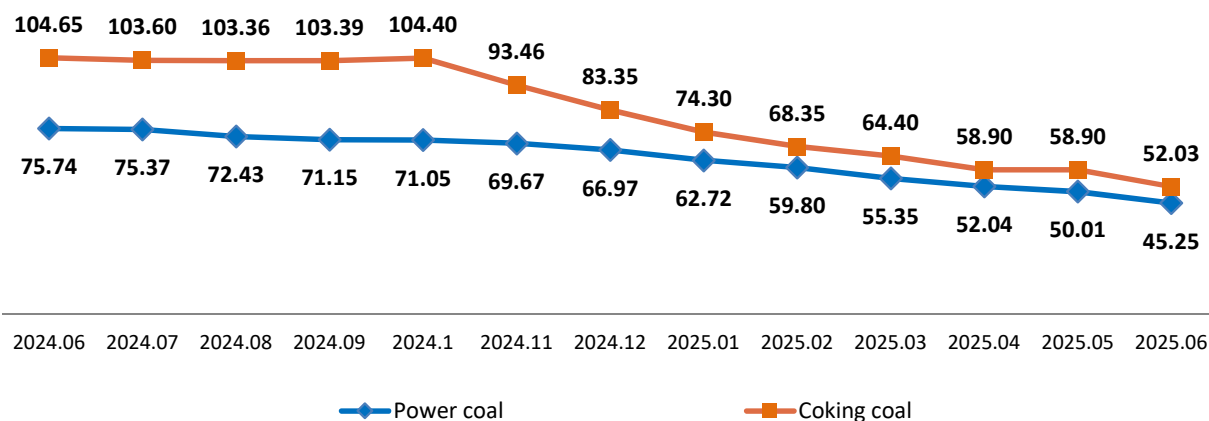

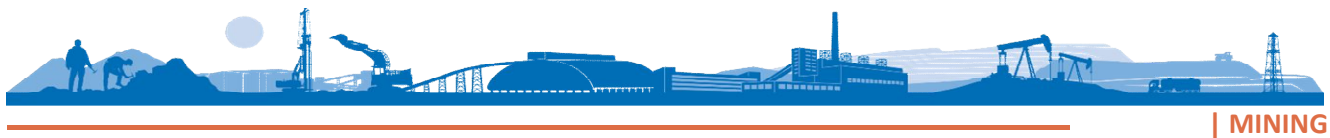

3.16. COAL PRODUCTION, SALE AND EXPORT, 2023-2025, by ths.tons



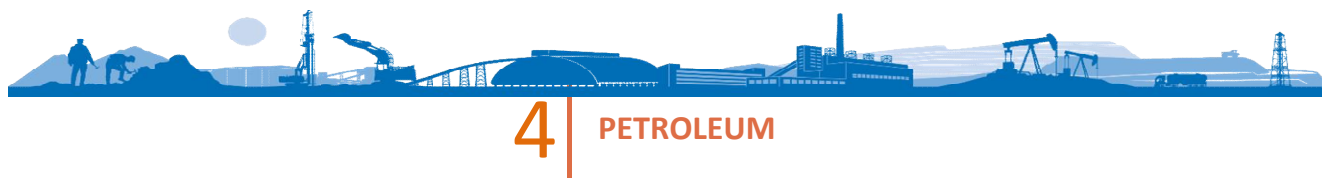

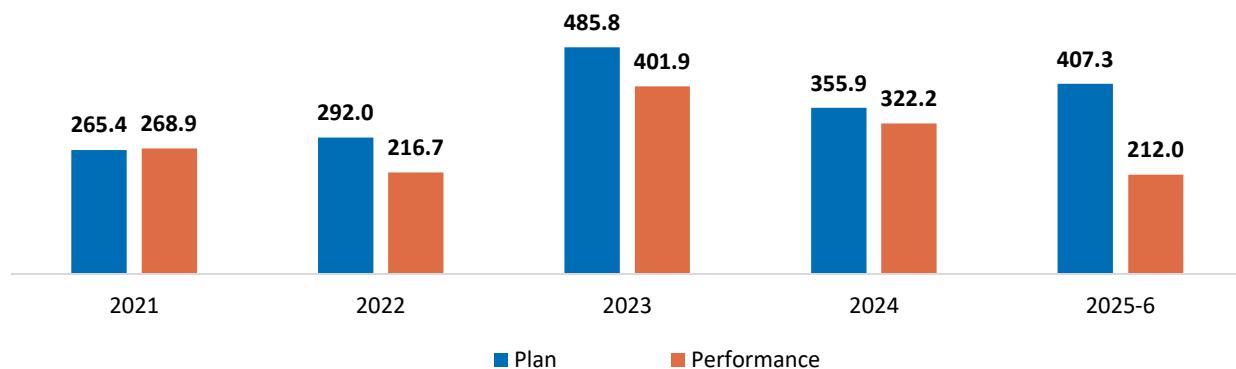

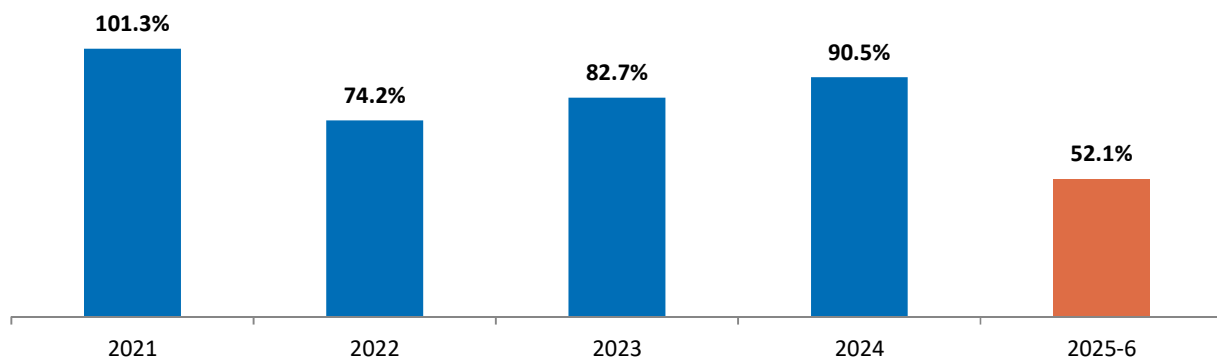

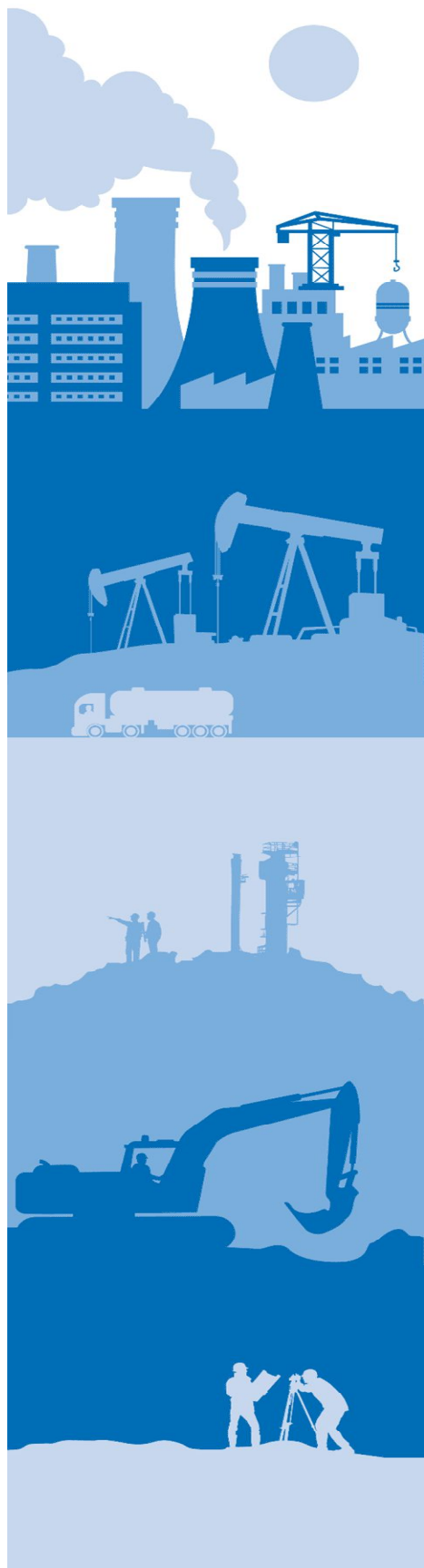
5.2. BUDGET REVENUE OF MRPAM, 2021-2025, by billion MNT
